MEDIA WALL ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



WARNINGS

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS, PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE ASSEMBLY AND RETAIN FOR FURTHER REFERENCE.

SAFETY AND PREPARATION:

- This pergola is heavy and needs three adults to put it together safely.
- Don't try to build the pergola in strong winds, rain, or storms. Wait for a calm, dry day.
- Before you start, look for any underground pipes, cables, or wires where you plan to build. If you're not sure, call your local utility company.
- Always wear safety glasses, work gloves, and closed-toe shoes when working with tools and aluminium parts.
- Aluminium can have sharp edges. Be careful when handling the parts.
- If you need a ladder, make sure it's stable and on a level surface. Have someone hold the ladder if possible.
- Keep children and pets away from the work area while you're building.
- Only use the tools listed in the "Tools Required" section. Using the wrong tools can be dangerous and damage the pergola.
- Do not hang excessive weight from the pergola. It is meant to support its own structure and light decorative items.
- Make sure the ground where you're building is sturdy, level and stable. If it's not, you will need to level it before you start.
- Read all the instructions carefully before you start. This will help you understand the steps and avoid mistakes.
- Make sure you have all the parts listed in the "Parts List." If anything is missing or damaged, contact our customer service help line at 08007555002.
- Clear the area where you're building the pergola. Remove any furniture, plants, or other obstacles.
- Lay out all the parts in order, so you can easily find them when you need them.
- Building a pergola takes time. Don't try to rush. Plan to spend a few hours on the project.
- As floor materials vary, screws for fixing to floor are not included.

TOOLS REQUIRED:

- Measuring Tape.
- Spirit Level.
- Drill with appropriate drill bits.
- Alan Key Set.
- Screwdriver (Phillips and flat-head).
- Ladder.
